

Aleksandra Stokłosa

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Polish soprano soloist, with a wide spectrum of vocal possibilities, actress skilled, gifted to play the most difficult soprano roles. Working as Soloist by Silesian Opera in Bytom, cooperates with well know directors, singers & orchestras, both: polish & abroad.

All works and the art activities, done by Aleksandra are on very high level of professionalism, for a special attention deserves roles of Abigaille (Verdi's "Nabucco"), Countess Rosina Almaviva in W.A. Mozart's "Le nozze di Figaro" (tournee through Holland with international cast of soloists), Tatiana in "Eugene Oniegin" written by P. Tchaikowsky.

Aleksandra focuses on soprano's roles, which needs extraordinary predispositions, but also streches beyond the classical Opera repertoire to get experience in oratorios & cantatas as Bruckner's "Te Deum", "Messiah" by G. F. Haendel and the "Mass in C Major" written by W. A. Mozart.
